

Summary

In 2019, the trade level between U.S. and Hong Kong decreased significantly with an over 15 percentage point.

In 2019, U.S. exports to Hong Kong totaled \$30.8 billion, a 17.4% (\$6.5 billion) decrease from 2018; U.S. imports from Hong Kong totaled \$4.7 billion, a 25.0% (\$1.5 billion) decrease; and the trade surplus was \$26.1 billion, a 15.9% (\$4.9 billion) decrease. The U.S. maintains a trade surplus with Hong Kong with a five year average of \$31.3 billion.

In 2019, of \$30.8 billion in U.S. exports to Hong Kong, the top commodity sectors were Machinery and Mechanical Appliances (39.9%), Stone, Glass, & Semiprecious Metals (19.5%) and Agriculture products (10.4%).

In 2019, of \$4.7 billion in U.S. imports from Hong Kong, the top commodity sectors were Special Classification Items, such as items under Temporary Legislation; Temporary Modifications proclaimed pursuant to Trade Agreements Legislation; Additional Import Restrictions Proclaimed Pursuant to Section 22 of the Agricultural Adjustment Act (47.3%), Stone, Glass, & Semiprecious Metals (20.4%), and Machinery and Mechanical Appliances (12.8%).

In 2019, BIS reviewed 279 export/re-export applications (not including deemed export applications) valued at \$2.0 billion for Hong Kong, out of a total of 32,993 applications worldwide for tangible items, software and technology valued at \$512.6 billion. Approved applications for Hong Kong totaled 192 (68.8% of the total applications) for \$1.9 billion, compared to the 28,223 (85.8%) approved applications for all destinations that totaled \$476.7 billion.

In 2019, BIS did not review any deemed export application from Hong Kong.

In 2019, BIS approved a license value of \$1,889.6 million for Hong Kong, much higher than the approval value of two millions to five millions in the previous years. The top ECCN by value is 5A991 for Telecommunication Equipment not controlled by 5A001. BIS also approved \$15.7 million for 5x515 items of Space Craft and Satellite.


In 2019, BIS denied a total of 31 licenses applications, much higher than the denials of 3 to 8 in the previous years. Of these, most of denials are for items used by police and items of firearms, such as 1A984 for Tear Gas (7 denials), 0A982 (5 denial) for Handcuffs, Leg Iron and Shackles, 0A979 for Police Helmets, Shields and Parts), and 0A985 for Discharge Type Arms and Devices to Administer Electric Shock (one denial with a high value of \$4.6 million).

In 2019, the average processing time for Hong Kong is 34 days.



I. Total U.S. Trade in goods with Hong Kong

In 2019, U.S. exports to Hong Kong totaled \$30.8 billion, a 17.4% (\$6.5 billion) decrease from 2018; U.S. imports from Hong Kong totaled \$4.7 billion, a 25.0% (\$1.5 billion) decrease; and the trade surplus was \$26.1 billion, a 15.9% (\$4.9 billion) decrease.



In 2019, <u>1.9%</u> of total <u>U.S. exports</u> were shipped to Hong Kong while <u>0.2%</u> of total <u>U.S. Imports</u> were delivered from Hong Kong during the same period. In 2019, the level of U.S. exports to Hong Kong and imports from Hong Kong are currently below the five year average level by value not adjusted for inflation. The U.S. maintains a trade surplus with Hong Kong with a five year average of \$31.3 billion.



II. U.S. Exports to Hong Kong subject to U.S. Government Filing Requirements

- In 2019, of the \$30.8 billion in U.S. exports to Hong Kong:
 - \$450.8 million (1.5% of the total exports) were subject to a BIS license requirement:
 - 0.03% were exported under a BIS license; Worldwide, 0.4% were exported under a BIS license.
 - 1.4% were exported under a BIS license exception; Worldwide, 1.0% were exported under a BIS license exception.
 - 15.9% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN and 600 series .y Subparagraph under No License Required (NLR); Worldwide, 12.1% were exported under NLR with an ECCN and 600 series .y Subparagraph under NLR.






U.S. Exports to Hong Kong


In 2019, U.S. exports to Hong Kong shipped under a BIS license exception totaled \$440.9 million, a 1.9% (\$8.2 million) increase from 2018.




In 2019, the top license exception Encryption commodities, Software and Technology (ENC) totaled \$270.1 million (61.3% of all license exceptions).




III. BIS Licensing to Hong Kong


