


### I. Total U.S. Trade in goods with European Union

In 2019, U.S. exports to European Union totaled \$337.0 billion, a 5.9% (\$18.6 billion) increase from 2018; U.S. imports from European Union totaled \$514.9 billion, a 5.7% (\$27.8 billion) increase; and the trade deficit was \$177.9 billion, a 5.5% (\$9.2 billion) increase.



In 2019, <u>20.5%</u> of total <u>U.S. exports</u> were shipped to European Union while <u>20.6%</u> of total <u>U.S. Imports</u> were delivered from European Union during the same period. In 2019, both the level of U.S. exports to European Union, and U.S. import from European Union are above the prior five-year average level by value not adjusted for inflation. The U.S. trade balance with European Union is negative.

In 2019, of the \$337.0 billion in U.S. exports to European Union, the top commodity sectors were Chemicals, Plastics and Leather products (20.5%), Transportation Equipment (20.0%), and Machinery and Mechanical Appliances (17.0%).

In 2019, of the \$514.9 billion in U.S. imports from European Union, the top commodity sectors were Chemicals, Plastics and Leather products (28.3%), Machinery and Mechanical Appliances (22.2%), and Transportation Equipment (14.0%).



### II. U.S. Exports to European Union subject to U.S. Government Filing Requirements


- In 2019, of the \$337.0 billion in U.S. exports to European Union:
  - 0 1.8% were subject to a BIS license requirement
    - 0.3% were exported under a BIS license; Worldwide, 0.4% were exported under a BIS license.
    - 1.4% were exported under a BIS license exception; Worldwide, 1.0% were exported under a BIS license exception.
    - 17.5% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN; Worldwide, 12.1% were exported under NLR with an ECCN reported
    - 0.02% were exported under NLR for .y 600-series items; Worldwide, 0.02% were exported under NLR for .y 600-series items.







In 2019, U.S. exports to European Union shipped under a BIS license exception totaled \$4.8 billion, an 11.1% (\$602.4 million) decrease from 2018.




The top license exception Encryption commodities, Software and Technology (ENC) totaled \$3.2 billion (65.6% of all license exceptions).







In 2018 and 2019, there were significant decreases in both Encryption commodities, Software and Technology (ENC) and Strategic Trade Authorization (STA) to European Union. Since 2017, STA shipments to the European Union decreased 63.4% from \$1.1 billion in 2017 to \$387.9 million in 2019.




### **III. BIS Licensing to European Union**

In 2019, BIS reviewed 5,099 export/re-export applications (not including deemed export applications) valued at \$12.8 billion for European Union, out of a total of 32,993 applications worldwide for tangible items, software and technology valued at \$158.8 billion.


- Approved applications for European Union totaled 4,512 (88.5% of the total applications) valued at \$2.8 billion, compared to 28,223 (85.5%) approved for all destinations valued at \$123.0 billion.

In 2019, BIS approved 86 deemed export applications from European Union nationals, out of 1,320 applications worldwide for deemed exports.
