

U.S. Trade with Canada

I. Total U.S. Trade in goods with Canada

In 2019, U.S. exports to Canada totaled \$292.4 billion, a 2.5% (\$7.4 billion) decrease from 2018; U.S. imports from Canada totaled \$319.7 billion, a 0.3% (\$0.91 billion) increase; and the trade deficit was \$27.4 billion, a 43.5% (\$8.3 billion) increase.



In 2019, the level of U.S. exports to, and U.S. imports from Canada exceeded the prior five-year average level by value not adjusted for inflation. In 2019, the U.S. trade balance with Canada was negative.



U.S. Trade with Canada

In 2019, of the \$292.4 billion in U.S. exports to Canada, the top commodity sectors were Machinery and Mechanical Appliances (23.7%), Transportation Equipment (21.5%), and Chemicals, Plastics, and Leather products (13.9%).

In 2019, of the \$319.7 billion in U.S. imports from Canada, the top commodity sectors were Minerals (27.3%), Transportation Equipment (19.0%), and Chemicals, Plastics, and Leather products (10.2%).



Canada maintains a significant share of the U.S.-World Trade. In 2019, **17.8%** of total U.S. exports of \$1.6 trillion to the World were shipped to Canada and **12.8%** of total U.S. Imports of \$2.5 trillion were imported from Canada.

Exports

In 2019, the U.S. exported \$8.2 billion worth of furniture, bedding, lamps, toys, games, sport equipment, paint and other miscellaneous manufactured items to Canada, representing 42.8% of the total U.S. exports to the World of those commodities. The U.S exports of \$9.3 billion worth of Word Products, represented 25.6% of the total U.S. exports to the World of those commodities. Additionally, the U.S. exported \$17.2 billion worth of Base Metals, representing 25.3% of the total U.S. exports of those commodities.

Imports

In 2019, the U.S. imported \$87.4 billion worth of Minerals from Canada, representing 42.0% of the total U.S. imports of those commodities. The U.S. imported \$16.8 billion worth of Wood Products, representing 38.7% of total U.S. imports of those commodities. Additionally, the U.S. imported \$23.0 billion worth of Base Metals, representing 18.2% of the total U.S. imports of those commodities.

II. U.S. Exports to Canada subject to U.S. Government Filing Requirements


In 2019, of the \$292.4 billion in U.S. exports to Canada:

- o 0.1% were subject to a BIS license requirement.
 - > 0.02% were exported under a BIS license; Worldwide, 0.4% were exported under a BIS license.
 - ➤ 0.1% were exported under a BIS license exception; Worldwide, 1.0% were exported under a BIS license exception.
- o 0.4% were exported under No License Required (NLR) with an ECCN; Worldwide, 12.1% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN.
- 0.01% were exported under NLR for .y 600-series items; Worldwide, 0.02% was exported under NLR for .y 600-series items.






U.S. Exports to Canada

In 2019, U.S. exports to Canada shipped under a BIS license exception totaled \$221.0 million, a \$103.1 million (31.8%) decrease from 2018.





In 2019, the top license exception, Servicing and Replacement of Parts and Equipment (RPL), totaled \$113.9 million (51.6% of all license exceptions) followed by Encryption Commodities, Software and Technology (ENC) with \$73.1 million (33.1%).




BIS License Determination Trends for Canada

III. BIS Licensing to Canada

In 2019, BIS reviewed 895 export/re-export applications (not including deemed export applications) valued at \$6.7 billion for Canada, out of a total of 32,993 applications worldwide valued at \$158.8 billion.

- Approved applications for Canada totaled 767 (85.5% of the total applications) for \$3.5 billion, compared to 28,223 (85.5%) approved applications for all destinations valued at \$123.0 billion.




In 2019, BIS reviewed seven deemed export applications from Canadian nationals, out of a total of 1,320 applications worldwide.

Approved deemed exports applications from Canadian nationals totaled 4 (57.1% of the total applications), compared to the 1,124 (85.2%) approved for all destination.
