BULK LICENSES FACTSHEET



Bulk licenses authorize the export or reexport of items based on a representative list of items, similar to the bulk licenses granted by the Directorate of Defense Trade Controls. An applicant that regularly supplies various parts and components to a single buyer for one or more platforms may benefit from the bulk license. As with all BIS licenses, purchase orders are not required for exporters to submit a license application.

The key requirement for a bulk license is a representative parts list. A representative parts list is used to illustrate the type of parts to be shipped and the applicant's ability to properly self classify (See example below). The list should contain the following information:

- 1. Platform/system to be supported
- 2. Part numbers or National Stock Number
- 3. Technical description
- 4. ECCN of each part (identified to the paragraph or subparagraph level)

When multiple platforms are to be supported, the parts list should be broken down by platform type (e.g., F-15, C-130, Grippen, etc.). For each ECCN in Block 22 in SNAP-R, enter the ECCN, a quantity of "1," units of "LOT," the technical description listing the platforms to be supported, and the associated dollar amount requested. The length of the attached list should be commensurate with the dollar amounts (i.e., a \$100,000 list would be shorter than a \$5 million list). The list may be representative or comprehensive, but should be clearly labeled as such in either case.
