


## I. Total U.S. Trade with Hong Kong

In 2016, U.S. exports to Hong Kong totaled \$34.9 billion, a 6.1% (\$2.3 billion) decrease from 2015; U.S. imports from Hong Kong totaled \$7.4 billion, a 8.7% (\$590.7 million) increase; and the trade surplus was \$27.5 billion, a 9.4% (\$2.8 billion) decrease.

Of the \$34.9 billion in U.S. exports to Hong Kong in 2016, the top commodity sectors were machinery and mechanical appliances (34.7%), stone, glass and semiprecious metals (27.7%) and agriculture products (11.6%).

Of the \$7.4 billion in U.S. imports from Hong Kong in 2016, the top commodity sectors were stone, glass and semiprecious metals (36.2%) and special classification items (27.0%).

## II. Exports to Hong Kong subject to US Government Filing Requirements

Of the \$34.9 billion in U.S. exports to Hong Kong in 2016:


- 1.2% were subject to a BIS license requirement
  - o 0.02% were exported under a BIS license; Worldwide, 0.5% were exported under a BIS license.
  - 1.2% were exported under a BIS license exception; Worldwide, 1.6% were exported under a BIS license exception.
- 18.1% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN; Worldwide, 12.2% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN.





In 2016, U.S. exports to Hong Kong shipped under a BIS license exception totaled \$414.4 million, a 8.7% (\$39.3 million) decrease from 2015. The top license exception Encryption commodities, Software and Technology (ENC) totaled \$387.3 million (93.5% of all license exceptions).



#### Licensing to Hong Kong subject to US Government Filing Requirements **III**.

In 2016, BIS reviewed 257 export/re-export applications (not including deemed export applications) valued at \$374.8 million for Hong Kong, out of a total of 33,195 applications worldwide valued at \$235.4 billion.

Approved applications for Hong Kong totaled 194 (75.5% of the total applications) for \$326.0 million, compared to the 28,214 (85.0%) approved applications for all destinations that totaled \$210.3 billion.
