


Office of Technology Evaluation Statistical Analysis of U.S. Trade with the United Arab Emirates (UAE)

I. **Total U.S. Trade with the United Arab Emirates**

In 2016, U.S. exports to the UAE totaled \$22.4 billion, a 2.7% (\$621.8 million) decrease from 2015; U.S. imports from the UAE totaled \$3.4 billion, a 36.0% (\$888.0 million) increase; and the trade deficit was \$19.0 billion, a 7.4% (\$1.5 billion) decrease in the deficit from 2015.

Of the \$22.4 billion in U.S. exports to the UAE in 2016, the top commodity sectors were Transportation Equipment (40.5%), Machinery and Mechanical Appliances (23.4%), and Stone, Glass, & Semiprecious Metals (8.9%).

Of the \$3.4 billion in U.S. imports from the UAE in 2016, the top commodity sectors were Base Metals (37.5%) and Specials Items (24.5%).


II. Exports to the Philippines subject to US Government Filing Requirements

Of the \$22.4 billion in U.S. exports to the UAE in 2016:

- 1.5% were subject to a BIS license requirement
 - o 0.8% were exported under a BIS license; Worldwide, 0.5% were exported under a BIS license.
 - 0.7% were exported under a BIS license exception; Worldwide, 1.6% were exported under a BIS license exception.
- 29.7% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN; Worldwide, 12.2% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN.






In 2016, U.S. exports to the UAE shipped under a BIS license exception totaled \$160.3 million, a 18.4% (\$36.1 million) decrease from 2015.




The top license exception Encryption commodities, Software and Technology (ENC) totaled \$87.5 million (54.6% of all license exceptions).

2016 U.S. Exports to United Arab Emirates by BIS License Exceptions \$millions








III. BIS licensing to the United Arab Emirates

In 2016, BIS reviewed 896 export/re-export applications (not including deemed export applications) valued at \$2.0 million for UAE, out of a total of 33,195 applications worldwide valued at \$235.4 billion.

• Approved applications for UAE totaled 793 (88.5% of the total applications) for \$1.9 million, compared to the 28,214 (85.0%) approved applications for all destinations that totaled \$210.3 billion.
