


Office of Technology Evaluation Statistical Analysis of U.S. Trade with the United Kingdom (U.K.)

I. Total U.S. Trade with the United Kingdom

In 2016, U.S. exports to the U.K. totaled \$55.4 billion, a 1.3% (\$718.5 million) decrease from 2015; U.S. imports from the U.K. totaled \$54.3 billion, a 6.3% (\$3.6 billion) decrease; and the U.S. trade with U.K. has a trade surplus of \$1.1 billion after four consecutive years of trade deficit.

Of the \$55.4 billion in U.S. exports to the U.K. in 2016, the top commodity sectors were transportation equipment (25.8%), machinery and mechanical appliances (17.3%), and chemicals, plastics, leather goods (14.8%).

Of the \$54.3 billion in U.S. imports from the U.K. in 2016, the top commodity sectors were chemicals, plastics, leather goods (21.7%), transportation equipment (20.6%) and machinery and mechanical appliances (17.6%).


II. Exports to the United Kingdom subject to US Government Filing Requirements

Of the \$55.4 billion in U.S. exports to the U.K. in 2016:

- 2.5% were subject to a BIS license requirement
 - o 0.5% were exported under a BIS license; Worldwide, 0.5% were exported under a BIS license.
 - 2.0% were exported under a BIS license exception; Worldwide, 1.6% were exported under a BIS license exception.
- 24.7% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN; Worldwide, 12.2% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN.








Government Filing Requirements


In 2016, U.S. exports to the U.K. shipped under a BIS license exception totaled \$1,104.3 billion, a 0.7% (\$8.2 million) decrease from 2015. The top license exception in 2016 was Encryption Commodities, Software and Technology (ENC) totaled \$736.0 billion (66.6% of all license exceptions).








Government Filing Requirements



In 2016, U.S. exports to the U.K. under BIS License Exception Strategic Trade Authorization increased by 128.3% (\$61.2 million) from \$47.7 million to \$108.9 million.



III. BIS Licensing to the United Kingdom

In 2016, BIS reviewed 1,832 export/re-export applications (not including deemed export applications) valued at \$6.2 billion for the U.K., out of a total of 33,195 applications worldwide valued at \$235.4 billion.

-Approved applications for the U.K. totaled 1,607 (87.7% of the total applications) for \$4.7 billion, compared to the 28,214 (85.0%) approved applications for all destinations that totaled \$210.3 billion.
