
## Israel

## I. Total U.S. Trade in goods with Israel

In 2018, U.S. exports to Israel totaled \$13.7 billion, a 9.3% (\$1.1 billion) increase from 2017; U.S. imports from Israel totaled \$21.8 billion, a 0.8% (\$181.2 million) decrease; and the trade deficit was \$8.1 billion, a 14.3% (\$1.3 billion) decrease.



In 2018, <u>0.8%</u> of total <u>U.S. exports</u> were shipped to Israel while <u>0.9%</u> of total <u>U.S. Imports</u> were delivered from Israel. In 2018, the level of U.S. exports to Israel is above and the level of U.S. imports from the Israel is below the prior five-year average level by value. In the last six years, the U.S. keeps a trade deficit with Israel.

In 2018, of the \$13.7 billion in U.S. exports to Israel, the top commodity sectors were Stone, Glass, & Semiprecious Metals (36.1%), Machinery and Mechanical Appliances (19.4%) and Transportation Equipment (16.2%).

In 2018, of the \$21.8 billion in U.S. imports from Israel, the top commodity sectors were Stone, Glass, & Semiprecious Metals (36.7%), Chemicals, Plastics, and Leather (23.9%), and Machinery and Mechanical Appliances (12.8%).

## II. U.S. Exports to Israel subject to U.S. Government Filing Requirements


In 2018, of the \$13.7 billion in U.S. exports to Israel:

- o 5.0% were subject to a BIS license requirement
- o 2.6% were exported under a BIS license; Worldwide, 0.4% were exported under a BIS license.
- 2.3% were exported under a BIS license exception; Worldwide, 1.2% were exported under a BIS license exception.
- 15.2% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN; Worldwide, 12.1% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN.
- 0.07% were exported under NLR for .y 00-series items; Worldwide, 0.02% were exported under NLR for .y 600-series items.









In 2018, U.S. exports to Israel shipped under a BIS license exception totaled \$320 million, a 5.7% (\$17.1 million) increase from 2017.




In 2018, the top license exception Encryption commodities, Software and Technology (ENC) totaled \$212.8 million (66.5% of all license exceptions).



## III. BIS Licensing to Israel

In 2018, BIS reviewed 1,220 export/re-export applications (not including deemed export applications) valued at \$3.6 billion for Israel, out of a total of 33,844 applications worldwide valued at \$81.3 billion.

- Approved applications for Israel totaled 1,049 (86.0% of the total applications) for \$1.7 billion, compared to the 29,032 (85.8%) approved applications for all destinations that totaled \$64.3 billion.




In 2018, BIS reviewed 3 deemed export applications from Israel, out of a total of 1,007 applications worldwide.

- Approved applications for Israel totaled 2 (66.7% of the total applications), compared to the 846 (91.5% approved applications for all destinations.
