


## I. Total U.S. Trade in Goods with India

In 2019, U.S. exports to India totaled \$34.4 billion, a 2.7% (\$0.9 billion) increase from 2018; U.S. imports from India totaled \$57.7 billion, a 6.1% (\$3.3 billion) increase; and the trade deficit was \$23.3 billion, a 11.6% (\$2.4 billion) increase.



In 2019, <u>2.1%</u> of total <u>U.S. exports</u> were shipped to India while <u>2.3%</u> of total <u>U.S. Imports</u> were delivered from India. In 2019, the level of U.S. exports to, and U.S. imports from India exceeded the prior five-year average level by value not adjusted for inflation and the U.S. trade deficit with India is also exceeded the prior five-year average level by value not adjusted for inflation.

In 2019, of the \$34.4 billion in U.S. exports to India, the top commodity sectors were Minerals (24.2%), Stone, Glass, & Semiprecious Metals (19.0%), and Chemicals, Plastics, and Leather products (15.1%).

In 2019, of the \$57.7 billion in U.S. imports from India, the top commodity sectors were Chemicals, Plastics, and Leather products (23.4%), Stone, Glass, & Semiprecious Metals (19.9%), and Textile and Footwear (15.5%).

### II. Exports to India subject to US Government Filing Requirements


In 2019, of the \$34.4 billion in U.S. exports to India:

- 1.9% were subject to a BIS license requirement:
  - 0.7% were exported under a BIS license; Worldwide, 0.4% were exported under a BIS license.
  - 1.2% were exported under a BIS license exception; Worldwide, 1.0% were exported under a BIS license exception.
  - 7.5% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN and NLR for .y 600-series items:
    - ➤ 7.4% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN; Worldwide, 12.1% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN.
    - 0.04% were exported under NLR for .y 600-series items; Worldwide, 0.02% were exported under NLR for .y 600-series items.









In 2019, U.S. exports to India shipped under a BIS license exception totaled \$413.4 million, a 52.7% (\$142.6 million) increase from 2018.




In 2019, the top license exception Encryption Commodities, Software and Technology (ENC) totaled \$305.1 million (73.8% of all license exceptions), followed by Governments, International Organizations (GOV) at \$61.5 million (14.9%) and Strategic Trade Authorization (STA) at \$23.4 million (5.7%).



# III. BIS Licensing to India

In 2019, BIS reviewed 1,338 export/re-export applications (not including deemed export applications) valued at \$1.4 billion for India, out of a total of 32.993 applications worldwide for tangible items, software and technology valued at \$158 .8billion.

– Approved applications for India totaled 1,066 (79.7% of the total applications) for \$1.1 billion, compared to the 28,223 (85.5%) approved applications for all destinations valued at \$123.0 billion.





India is the top third destination for Deemed Exports after China and Iran. In 2019, BIS approved 67 (77.0% of total applications from India and 6.0% of the total approved) licenses for Deemed Exports, compared to 1,124 (85.2%) approved for all destinations.

In the last five years, there were no denials for Deemed Export applications for Indian nationals.
