

US Trade with Singapore Overall Trends

I. Total U.S. Trade in goods with Singapore

In 2019, U.S. exports to Singapore totaled \$31.5 billion, a 3.7% (\$1.2 billion) decrease from 2018; U.S. imports from Singapore totaled \$26.4 billion, a 0.9% (\$0.2 billion) decrease; and the trade deficit was \$5.2 billion, a 15.8% (\$1.0 billion) decrease.



In 2019, <u>1.9%</u> of total <u>U.S. exports</u> were shipped to Singapore while <u>1.1%</u> of total <u>U.S. Imports</u> were delivered from Singapore. In 2019, the level of U.S. exports to and imports from Singapore exceeded the prior five-year average level by value not adjusted for inflation. In 2019, the US trade balance with Singapore is positive.

US Trade with Singapore Overall Trends

In 2019, of the \$31.5 billion in U.S. exports to Taiwan, the top commodity sectors were Machinery and mechanical appliances (29.8%), Transportation equipment (20.3%), and Chemicals, Plastics, and Leather products (16.6%).

In 2019, of the \$26.4 billion in U.S. imports from Taiwan, the top commodity sectors were Chemicals, Plastics, and Leather products (28.2%), Machinery and mechanical appliances (24.9%), and Special Items (14.6%).

II. Exports to Singapore subject to US Government Filing Requirements

In 2019, of the \$31.5 billion in U.S. exports to Singapore:


- o 3.1% were subject to a BIS license requirement
 - 0.7 % were exported under a BIS license; Worldwide, 0.4% were exported under a BIS license.
 - 2.4% were exported under a BIS license exception; Worldwide, 1.0% were exported under a BIS license exception.
- o 26.5% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN; Worldwide, 12.1% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN.
- 0.04% were exported under NLR for .y 600-series items; Worldwide, 0.02% were exported under NLR for .y 600-series items.






US to Singapore Export Trade Trends

In 2019, U.S. exports to Singapore shipped under a BIS license exception totaled \$748.0 million, a 17.9% (\$113.7 million) increase from 2018.





The top license exception by value was Encryption commodities, Software and Technology (ENC) totaling \$597.7 million (79.9% of all license exceptions) reported for Singapore.





US Trade with Singapore License Determination Trends

III. BIS Licensing to Singapore

In 2019, BIS reviewed 812 export/re-export applications (not including deemed export applications) valued at \$3.4 billion for Singapore, out of a total of 32,993 applications worldwide for tangible items, software and technology valued at \$158.8 billion.

– Approved applications for Singapore totaled 712 (87.3% of the total applications) for \$1.6 billion compared to 28,223 (85.5%) approved for all destinations valued at \$123.0 billion.







US Trade with Singapore License Determination Trends

In 2019, BIS reviewed 3 deemed export applications from Singapore out of 1,320 applications worldwide for deemed exports.

Approved deemed export applications for Singapore totaled 3 (100%), compared to the 1,124 (85.2%) approved for all destinations.
