


U.S. Trade with South Korea

I. Total U.S. Trade in goods with South Korea

In 2019, U.S. exports to South Korea totaled \$56.9 billion, a 0.7% (\$0.4 billion) increase from 2018; U.S. imports from South Korea totaled \$77.5 billion, a 4.4% (\$3.2 billion) increase; and the trade deficit was \$20.6 billion, a 16.1% (\$2.9 billion) increase.



In 2019, <u>3.5%</u> of total <u>U.S. exports</u> were shipped to South Korea while <u>3.1%</u> of total <u>U.S. Imports</u> were delivered from South Korea during the same period. In 2019, the level of U.S. exports to, and U.S. import from South Korea exceeded the prior five-year average level by value not adjusted for inflation. The U.S. trade balance with South Korea is negative.

U.S. Trade with South Korea

In 2019, of the \$56.9 billion in U.S. exports to South Korea, the top commodity sectors were Minerals (24.1%), Machinery (21.5%), and Chemicals, Plastics, Leather products (15.6%).

In 2019, of the \$77.5 billion in U.S. imports from South Korea, the top commodity sectors were Machinery (37.6%), Transportation (28.1%), and Chemicals, Plastics, Leather products (12.7%).

II. U.S. Exports to South Korea subject to U.S. Government Filing Requirements

In 2019, of the \$56.9 billion in U.S. exports to South Korea:

- o 1.4% were subject to a BIS license requirement
 - 0.7% were exported under a BIS license; Worldwide, 0.4% were exported under a BIS license.
 - 0.7% were exported under a BIS license exception; Worldwide, 1.0% were exported under a BIS license exception.
- 10.8% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN; Worldwide, 12.1% were exported under NLR with an ECCN reported
- o 0.02% were exported under NLR for .y 600-seiries items; Worldwide, 0.02% were exported under NLR for .y 600-series items.




2019 U.S. Exports to South Korea: Export Authorizations by Regulatory Authority






U.S. Exports to South Korea

In 2019, U.S. exports to South Korea shipped under a BIS license exception totaled \$396.8 million, a 8.2% (\$35.4 million) decrease from 2018.





The top license exception Encryption commodities, Software and Technology (ENC) totaled \$171.2 million (43.1% of all license exceptions).


III. BIS Licensing to South Korea


In 2019, BIS reviewed 1,241 export/re-export applications (not including deemed export applications) valued at \$3.9 billion for South Korea, out of a total of 32,993 applications worldwide for tangible items, software and technology valued at \$512.6 billion.

- Approved applications for South Korea totaled 1,092 (88.0% of the total applications) valued at \$4.6 billion, compared to 28,223 (85.5%) approved for all destinations valued at \$476.7 billion.

In 2019, BIS reviewed six deemed export application from South Korea, out of 1,320 applications worldwide for deemed exports.

- BIS approved all six deemed exports application (100%), compared to the 1,124 (85.2%) approved for all destinations.
