

### U.S. Trade with Indonesia

### **Summary**

In 2020, <u>0.5%</u> of total <u>U.S. exports</u> were shipped to Indonesia while <u>0.9%</u> of total <u>U.S. Imports</u> were delivered from Indonesia. In 2020, U.S. exports to Indonesia were \$7.4 billion, a 4.1% (\$317.2 million) decrease from 2019; U.S. imports from Indonesia were \$20.2 billion, a 0.4% (\$79.8 million) increase; and the trade deficit was \$12.8 billion, a 3.2% (\$397.0 million) increase.

In 2020, the most traded commodity sectors of U.S.-Indonesia trade were Agricultural Goods, Textiles and Footwear, and Chemicals, Plastics and Leather products.

In 2020, BIS processed a total of 585 license applications valued at \$525.7 million for tangible items, software and technology for Indonesia. BIS approved 506, 86.5% of the total applications valued at \$449.7 million. RWA totaled 76 valued at \$75.8 million. There were three denials valued at \$200,000.

In 2020, BIS did not receive any applications from Indonesian nationals for deemed exports.

The top approved ECCNs were 9A610 for Military Aircraft and Related Commodities with 176 approvals; 2B350 for Chemical Manufacturing Facilities and Equipment with 59 approvals, and 9A619 for Military Gas Turbine Engines and Related Commodities with 44 approvals.

In 2020, \$72.7 million (1.0% of the total exports) was shipped under BIS licenses. In 2020, the top licensed ECCN by value was 9A619 for Military Gas Turbine Engines and Related Commodities, followed by 2B350 for Chemical Manufacturing Facilities and Equipment; and 9A610 for Military Aircraft and Related Commodities. In 2020, two firearms ECCNs, 0A503 and 0A504, were new additions to the top ten licensed ECCNs by value.

In 2020, \$34.5 million (0.5% of the total exports) was shipped under BIS license exception authorization. Of these, Encryption Commodities and Software accounted for 88.6%. The top ECCNs for license exceptions were 5A002 for Systems, Equipment, Integrated Circuits for Information Security; 9A610 for Military Aircraft and Related Commodities; and 5D002 for 'Software.'


In 2020, the average processing time for Indonesia was 17 days.



### U.S. Trade with Indonesia

### I. Total U.S. Trade in goods with Indonesia

In 2020, U.S. exports to Indonesia totaled \$7.4 billion, a 4.1% (\$317.2 million) decrease from 2019; U.S. imports from Indonesia totaled \$20.2 billion, a 0.4% (\$79.8 million) increase; and the trade deficit was \$12.8 billion, a 3.2% (\$397.0 million) increase.



In 2020, the level of U.S. exports to Indonesia and U.S. imports from Indonesia exceeded the prior five-year average level by value not adjusted for inflation; and the U.S. trade deficit with Indonesia is lower than the prior five-year average level by value.

### U.S. Trade with Indonesia

In 2020, of the \$7.4 billion in U.S. exports to Indonesia, the top commodity sectors were Agricultural Goods (34.3%), Minerals (17.1%), and Chemicals, Plastics, and Leather Goods (13.8%).

In 2020, of the \$20.2 billion in U.S. imports from Indonesia, the top commodity sectors were Textiles and Footwear (26.6%), Agricultural Goods (20.3%), and Machinery and Mechanical Appliances (14.7%).



In 2020, <u>0.5%</u> of total <u>U.S. exports</u> were shipped to Indonesia while <u>0.9%</u> of total <u>U.S. Imports</u> were delivered from Indonesia.

#### **Exports**

In 2020, the U.S. exported \$2.5 billion worth of Agricultural Goods to Indonesia, representing 2.0% of the total U.S. exports to the World of those commodities. The U.S. exports of \$411.9 million of Textiles and Footwear to Indonesia counted 1.7% of the total U.S. exports to the World of those commodities.

#### **Imports**

In 2020, the U.S. imported \$5.4 billion worth of Textiles and Footwear from Indonesia, representing 3.9% of the total U.S. imports of those commodities. The U.S. imports of \$4.1 billion of Agricultural Goods counted 2.5% of the total U.S. imports from the World of those commodities.





#### II. U.S. Exports to Indonesia subject to U.S. Government Filing Requirements

In 2020, of the \$7.4 billion in U.S. exports to Indonesia:

- 1.4% were subject to a BIS license requirement:
  - o 1.0% were exported under a BIS license; Worldwide, 0.5% were exported under a BIS license.
  - o 0.5% were exported under a BIS license exception; Worldwide, 1.0% were exported under a BIS license exception.
- 2.8% were exported under No License Required (NLR) with an ECCN; Worldwide, 10.7% were exported under NLR with an ECCN reported.
  - o 0.01% were exported under NLR for 600-series. y subparagraph items; Worldwide, 0.02% were exported under NLR for 600-series .y subparagraph items.
  - o 0.03% were exported under NLR for 0A501.y subparagraph Firearms items; Worldwide, 0.001% were exported under NLR for 0A501.y subparagraph Firearms items.




## U.S. Exports to Indonesia

In 2020, U.S. exports to Indonesia shipped under a BIS license exception totaled \$34.5 million, a \$13.2 million (27.6%) decrease from 2019.




In 2020, the top license exception, Encryption Commodities, Software and Technology (ENC), totaled \$30.5 million (88.6% of all license exceptions) followed by Servicing & Replacement of Parts & Equipment (RPL) with \$2.3 million (6.7%).



#### III. BIS Licensing to Indonesia


In 2020, BIS reviewed 585 export/re-export applications (not including deemed export applications) valued at \$525.7 million for Indonesia, out of a total of 38,203 applications worldwide for tangible items, software and technology valued at \$219.4 billion.

– Approved applications for Indonesia totaled 506 (86.5% of the total applications) for \$449.7 million, compared to 32,996 (86.4%) approved for all destinations valued at \$120.5 billion.



In 2020, there were no applications for Deemed Exports from Indonesian nationals, compared to 1,216 applications worldwide for deemed exports.

In the last five years, there were no denials for Deemed Export applications for Indonesian nationals.
