

U.S. Trade with Venezuela

Summary

In 2020, the U.S. trade with Venezuela further declined after the precipitous decline in 2019; and for the first time in the last six years, U.S. had a trade surplus. In 2020, U.S. exports to Venezuela totaled \$1.1 billion, a 12.2% (\$157.1 million) decrease; U.S. imports from Venezuela totaled \$167.6 million, a 91.3% (\$1.8 billion) decrease; and, the trade surplus was \$963.8 million.

In 2020, U.S. exports to Venezuela were concentrated in Agricultural Products and Machinery and Mechanical Appliances. In 2020, Agricultural Products constituted 38.5% of the total U.S. exports and Machinery and Mechanical Appliances were 29.1% of the total. In 2019, Agricultural Products constituted only 13.6% while Machinery and Mechanical Appliances were an identical 29.1%.

In 2020, U.S. exports to Venezuela shipped under a BIS license exception authorization totaled \$5.4 million, an increase of \$1.2 million from 2019. In 2020, the use of the license exception Encryption Commodities and Software (ENC) increased to \$5.1 million from \$1.4 million in 2019, and the top ECCN was 5A002 for Systems, Equipment, and Integrated Circuits for Information Security.

In 2020, BIS reviewed 19 export/re-export license applications (not including deemed export applications) for tangible items, software and technology valued at \$123.2 million for Venezuela. In 2020, BIS approved 8 (42.1% of the total applications) for \$123.0 million, RWA totaled 11 for \$0.1 million, and there were no denied applications.

In 2020, the top approved ECCNs, including ECCNs for deemed exports, were 2B350 for Chemical manufacturing facilities and equipment with 7 approvals; 5E001 for Technology with 3 approvals; and 3E001 for Technology for the development, production, use of certain items in 3A, 3B, and 3C with 3 approvals. Compared with 2019, 2B350 remained the top approved ECCN.


In 2020, the average processing time for Venezuela was 24 days.



U.S. Trade with Venezuela

I. Total U.S. Trade in goods with Venezuela

In 2020, the U.S. trade with Venezuela further declined after the precipitous decline in 2019; and for the first time in the last five years, U.S. had a trade surplus with Venezuela. In 2020, U.S. exports to Venezuela totaled \$1.1 billion, a 12.2% (\$157.1 million) decrease; U.S. imports from Venezuela totaled \$167.6 million, a 91.3% (\$1.8 billion) decrease; and, the trade surplus was \$963.8 million.



In 2020, <u>0.1%</u> of total <u>U.S. exports</u> were shipped to Venezuela while <u>0.01%</u> of total <u>U.S. Imports</u> were delivered from Venezuela. In 2020, both the level of U.S. exports to, and U.S. imports from Venezuela is below the prior five-year average level by value not adjusted for inflation. The U.S. trade balance with Venezuela is positive for the first time in the five-year timespan.



U.S. Trade with Venezuela

In 2020, of the \$1.1 billion in U.S. exports to Venezuela, the top commodity sectors were Agricultural Products (38.5%), Machinery and Mechanical Appliances (29.1%), and Chemicals, Plastics, Leather Goods (10.4%).

In 2020, of the \$167.6 million in U.S. imports from Venezuela, the top commodity sectors were Agricultural Products (67.8%), Machinery and Mechanical Appliances (10.2%), and Minerals (9.0%).



U.S. Trade with Venezuela in Mineral and Oil

In 2020, the U.S. trade with Venezuela in minerals and oil declined significantly. In 2020, U.S. exports of minerals and oil declined from \$325.5 million in 2019 to \$27.5 million, a decline of 91.6%. Similarly, U.S. imports of minerals and oil declined from \$1.6 billion in 2019 to \$15.1 million, a decline of 99.1%.


II. U.S. Exports to Venezuela subject to U.S. Government Filing Requirements

In 2020, of the \$1.1 billion in U.S. exports to Venezuela:

- There were no U.S. exports to Venezuela under ITAR and NLR .y subparagraph 600-series items.
- 0.5% were subject to a BIS license requirement
 - 0.01% were exported under a BIS license; Worldwide, 0.5% were exported under a BIS license.
 - 0.5% were exported under a BIS license exception; Worldwide, 1.0% were exported under a BIS license exception.
- 0.3% were exported under No License Required with an ECCN; Worldwide, 10.7% were exported under NLR with an ECCN reported






U.S. Exports to Venezuela

In 2020, U.S. exports to Venezuela shipped under a BIS license exception totaled \$5.4 million, a 26.2% (\$1.2 million) increase from 2019.





The top license exception Encryption Commodities and Software totaled \$5.1 million (94.8% of all license exceptions).



III. BIS Licensing to Venezuela


In 2020, BIS reviewed 19 export/re-export applications (not including deemed export applications) valued at \$123.2 million for Venezuela, out of a total of 38,203 applications worldwide for tangible items, software and technology valued at \$219.4 billion.

– Approved applications for Venezuela totaled 8 (42.1% of the total applications) valued at \$123.0 million, compared to 32,996 (86.4%) approved for all destinations valued at \$120.5 billion.



In 2020, BIS reviewed 3 deemed export application from Venezuela nationals, out of 1,216 applications worldwide for deemed exports.

- Approved deemed exports application were 3 (100%), compared to the 1,068 (87.8%) approved for all destinations.
