
## Statistics of the Second ECR Transition Rule - Vehicles and Vessels


October 15, 2013 to June 30, 2015

DDTC license applications covering the USML categories VI, VII, XIII, and XX showed a 42.6% decline from an average of 484 per month to 278 per month, a 206 average drop in license applications through July 7, 2015.


BIS License Applications for the Second ECR Transition Rule January 6, 2014 to June 30, 2015


The transactions related to the Second ECR Transition Rule - Vehicles and Vessels items (0y606, 0y617, 8y609 and 8y620) totaled 17,820 for 329.8 million. Commerce specific transactions totaled 17,742 for \$325.5 million.


U.S. Monthly Exports of the Second ECR Transition Rule Items under BIS Jurisdiction

Of the \$325.5 million exports of items in the Second ECR Transition Rule under BIS jurisdiction, licensed exports totaled \$212.7 million (65.3% of the total); NLR exports for .y 600-Series items totaled \$48.6 million (14.9%); NLR exports to Canada totaled \$27.9 million (8.6%); and STA totaled \$6.1 million (1.9%).
