

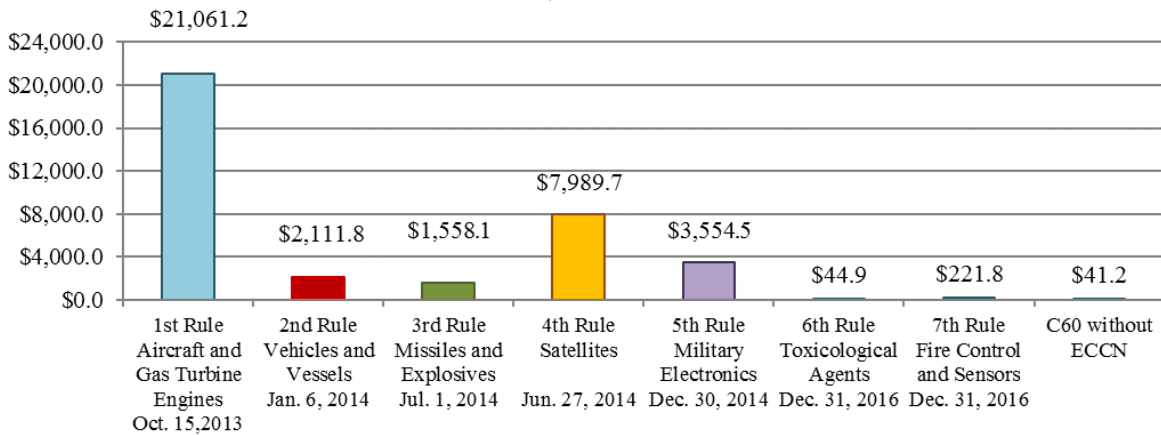
Statistics of U.S. Exports of 600-series and 9x515 Items

Total U.S. Exports of 600-Series and 9x515 Items

U.S. exports of 600-Series and 9x515 items from October 15, 2013 to March 31, 2019 totaled 517,775 shipments¹ for approximately \$36.6 billion under both BIS and DDTC authorization.

U.S. Exports of 600-Series and 9x515 Items by Value

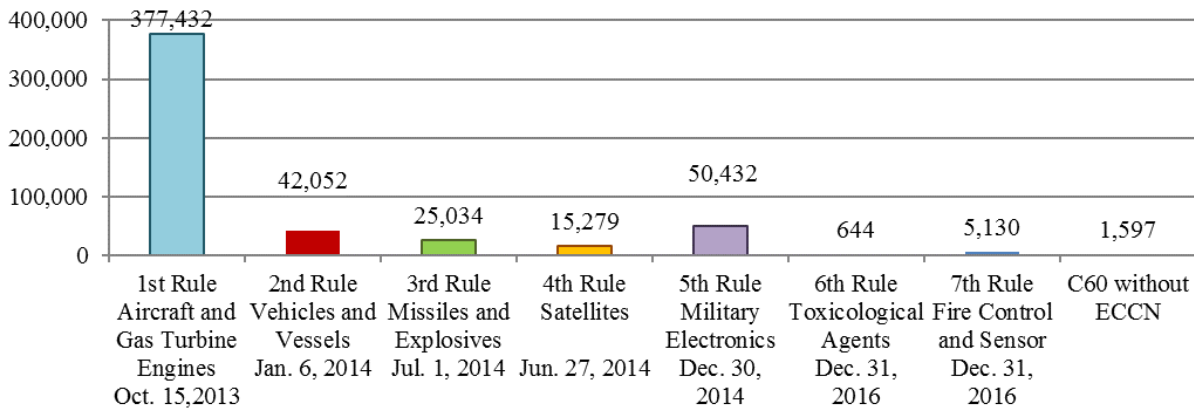

Effective Date to March 31, 2019

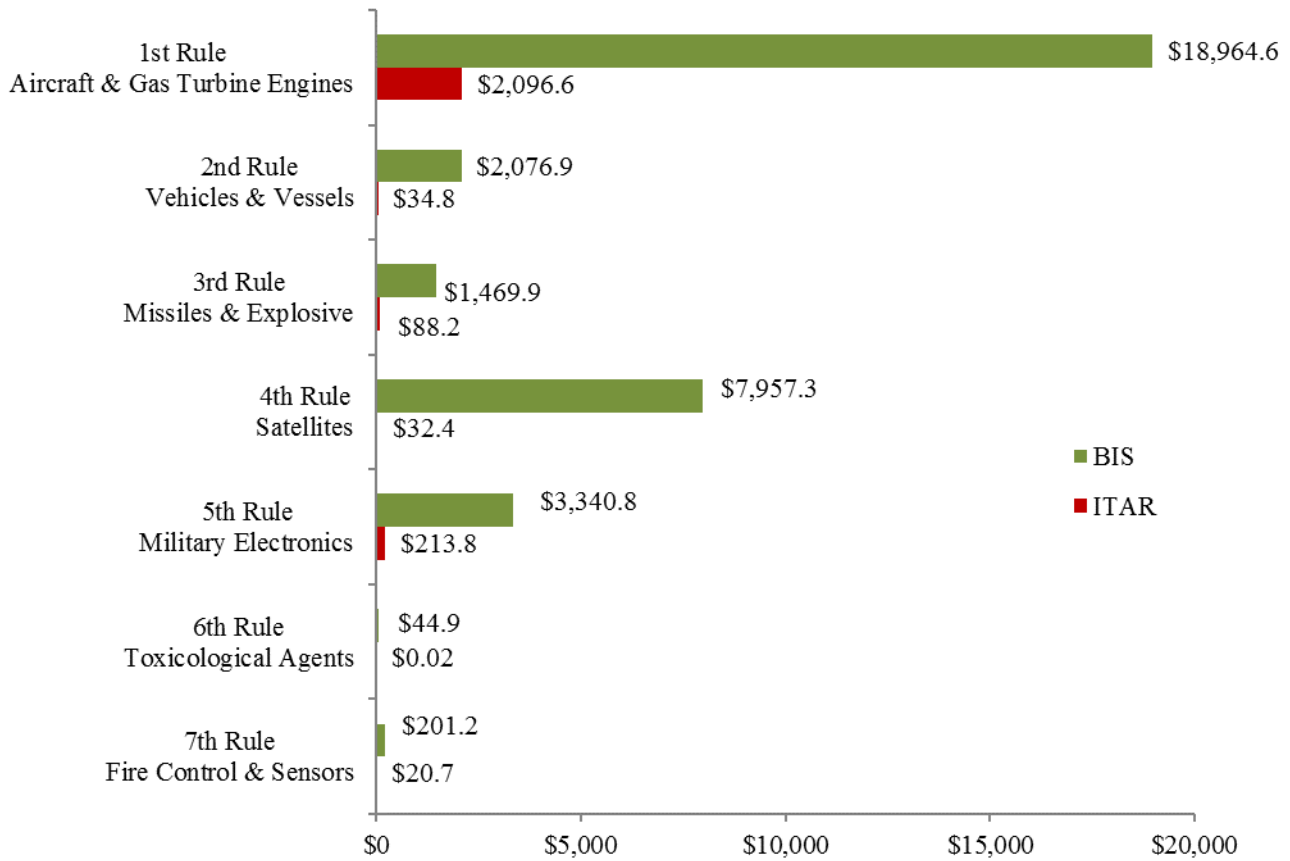

¹ Shipments are defined as exports being sent from one order party to one consignee located in a single country of destination on a single conveyance on the same day.

Of the \$36.6 billion in U.S. exports of 600-Series and 9x515 items from October 15, 2013 to March 31, 2019, \$34.1 billion (93.2 % of the total) was shipped under BIS authorization; and \$2.5 billion (6.8%) was shipped under DDTC authorization².

U.S. Exports of 600-Series Items under BIS Jurisdiction

Of the \$34.1 billion in U.S. exports under BIS jurisdiction from October 15, 2013 to March 31, 2019:

- \$26.1 billion were for 600-series items; and
- \$8.0 billion were for 9x515 items.

Of the \$26.1 billion in U.S. exports under BIS jurisdiction for 600-series items, the top 3 destinations were Japan with \$4.4 billion (16.9% of the total value), Canada with \$2.9 billion (11.0%) and the United Kingdom with \$2.6 billion (10.1%).

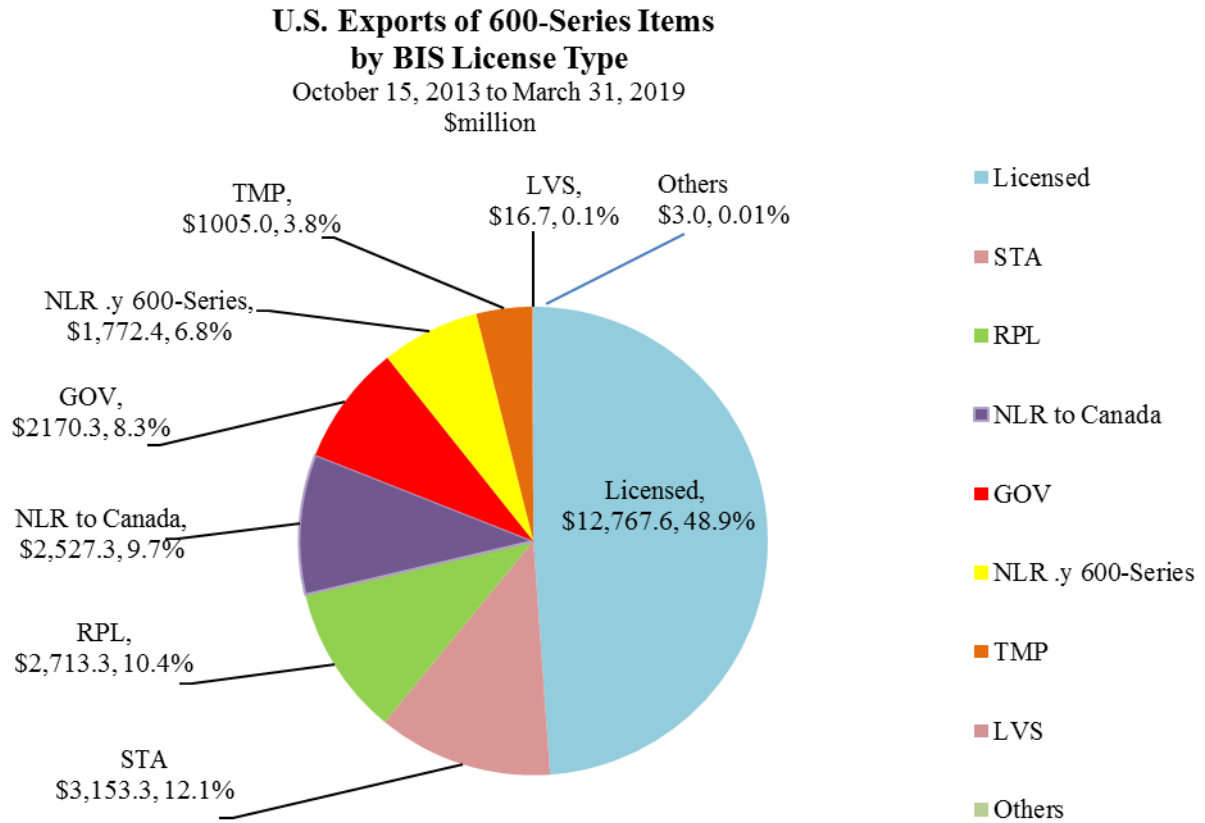

Of the \$26.1 billion in U.S. exports of 600-series items under BIS jurisdiction from October 15, 2013 to March 31, 2019, licensed exports totaled \$12.8 billion (48.9% of the total); STA totaled \$3.2 billion (12.1%); and RPL totaled \$2.7 billion (10.4%).

BIS License Exceptions:

STA: Strategic Trade Authorization

RPL: Servicing and replacement of parts and equipment

NLR: No License Required

GOV: Governments, international organizations, international inspections under the Chemical Weapons Convention, and the International Space Station

TMP: Temporary imports, exports, reexports, and transfers (in-country)

LVS: Shipments of limited value
