
The Seventh USML to CCL Regulatory Change Fire Control December 31, 2016 to December 31, 2016

Since the seventh USML to CCL regulatory change became effective on December 31, 2016 to August 31, 2020, BIS has processed a total of 2,327 licenses for a value of 1.4 billion for the four 600-Series items created by this rule. The average number of BIS license applications is 53 per month. BIS has approved a total of 2,084 license applications for a value of \$1.0 billion and the approval rate is 89.6%.




From the effective date of December 31, 2016 to August 31, 2020, U.S. exports of items in the Seventh USML to CCL regulatory change – Fire Control/sensors and night vision items (7x611) under BIS jurisdiction totaled 8,033 shipments with a shipped value of \$766.9 million.

Of \$766.9 million in U.S. exports of 600-series items in the sixth USML to CCL regulatory change under BIS jurisdiction from December 30, 2014 to August 31, 2020, Temporary imports, exports, reexports and transfers (in-country) totaled \$418.6 million (54.6%); licensed exports totaled \$211.9 million (27.6% of the total); and Servicing and replacement of parts and equipment totaled \$54.8 million (7.1%).
