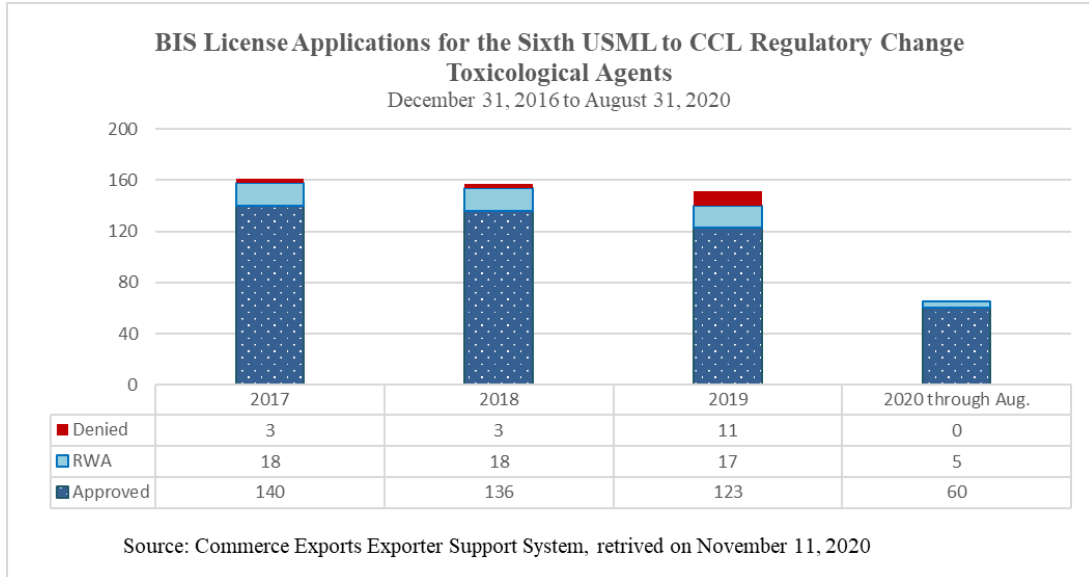


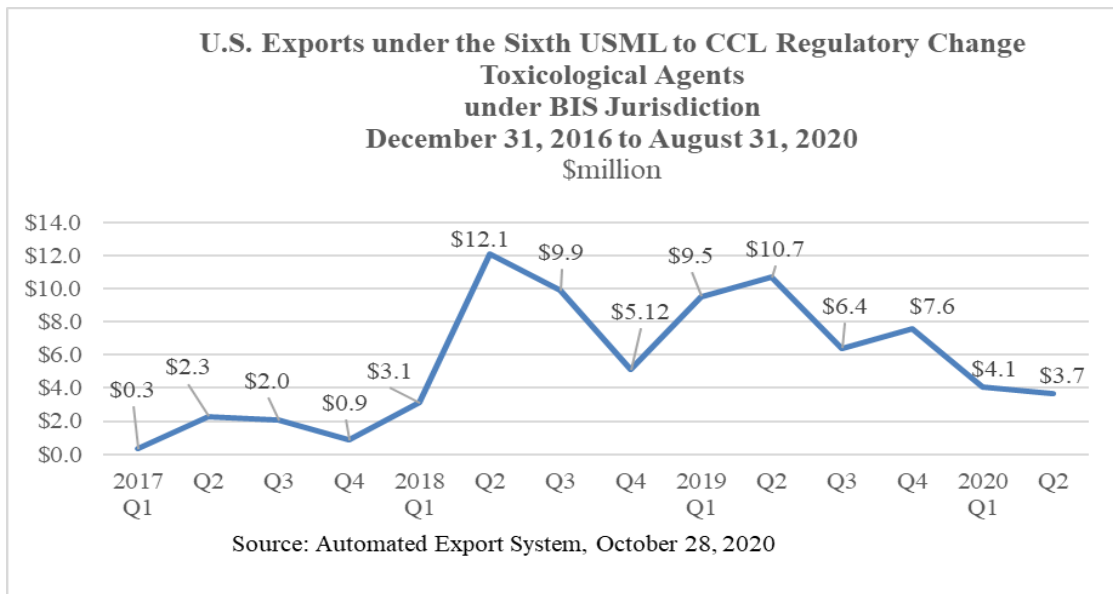
**The Sixth USML to CCL Regulatory Change
 Toxicological Agents**

December 31, 2016 to August 31, 2020

Since the sixth USML to CCL regulatory change became effective on December 31, 2016 to August 31, 2020, BIS has processed a total of 527 license applications for a value of \$148.1 million for the eight 600-Series items created by this rule. The average number of BIS license applications is 23 per month. BIS has approved a total of 457 licenses for a value of \$133.4 million with an approval rate of 86.1%.



From the effective date of December 31, 2016 to August 31, 2020, U.S. exports of items in the sixth USML to CCL regulatory change –Toxicological Agents items (1x607) under BIS jurisdiction totaled 1,153 shipments with a value of \$78.7 million.

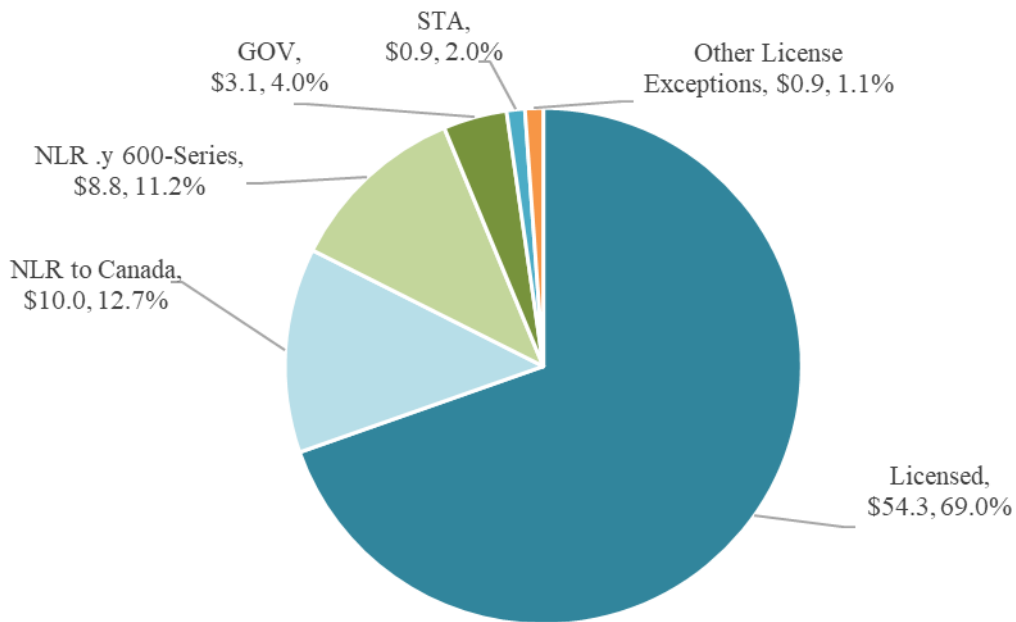

Of \$78.7 million in U.S. exports of 600-series items in the sixth USML to CCL regulatory change under BIS jurisdiction from December 30, 2014 to August 31, 2020, licensed exports totaled \$54.3 million (69.0% of the total); No License Required to Canada totaled \$10.0 million (12.7%); and No License Required for .y 600-series items totaled \$8.8 million (11.2%).
