

Effective Date to September 30, 2019





Of the \$40.9 billion in U.S. exports of 600-Series and 9x515 items from October 15, 2013 to September 30, 2019, \$37.8 billion (92.1 % of the total) was shipped under BIS authorization; and \$3.1 billion (7.9%) was shipped under DDTC authorization².

U.S. Exports of 600-Series Items under BIS Jurisdiction

Of the \$37.8 billion in U.S. exports under BIS jurisdiction from October 15, 2013 to September 30, 2019:

- > \$29.2 billion were for 600-series items; and
- > \$8.6 billion were for 9x515 items.

Of the \$29.2 billion in U.S. exports under BIS jurisdiction for 600-sereis items, the top 3 destinations by value were Japan with \$5.0 billion (17.1% of the total value), Canada with \$3.1 billion (10.6%) and the United Kingdom with \$2.9 billion (9.8%).



Of the \$29.2 billion in U.S. exports of 600-series items under BIS jurisdiction from October 15, 2013 to September 30, 2019, licensed exports totaled \$14.3 billion (48.9% of the total); STA totaled \$3.6 billion (12.2%); and RPL totaled \$3.0 billion (10.3%).
